Previous two months were filled with fruitful internal work in our congregation. At the beginning of November we held yet another session of the Bear Valley Bible institute Graduate program. We find it to be quite useful for the growth of the congregation in Lviv.

Also at the beginning of November we had some students from the Bachelors program of BVBIU who came to have their practice during the Fall Break. And during that week they taught Bible classes and were spreading Christian literature and Bibles on the streets and at the libraries. Also in this month we have finished our English through the Bible program

taught by our guests, the McConnell family. Due to this program we have more and more contacts with people for further evangelization.

At the end of November we had our second annual seminar on the church growth. As a guest speaker we invited a preacher from Slavyansk Albert Bagdasaryan (we invited him last year as well); the topic of the seminar in this year was «The history of the church».

In December we were getting ready to the New Year seminar «Kuroparty» that we've had for 5 years in a row. The topic of this seminar was «You are not alone» because of the loneliness that people feel even being around family and friends.

We continue having all of our regular Bible classes and singing practices.

During 2017 our small congregation had many evangelizing projects, multiple Bible classes and personal meetings with people in order to spread the Gospel. There was 1 baptism. The
