

## Dear brothers and sisters!

In September my ministry got started with a traditional trip to the town of Bila Tserkva to teach Homiletics for the 1st year students at the Bible Institute. As usual, it was a wonderful opportunity to teach the Bible to the next generations of the church of Christ ministers in Ukraine and to share my experience of church work.

This September became one of the happiest months for my family because our son Georgiy was born. We are grateful that God has blessed us with this second child and that our family grows.

This fall I started a series of personal Bible studies on the book of Acts with some Christians of our congregation in Lviv, who moved to God's church from denominations, in order to build them in truth and Bible knowledge.



I have started teaching a course on 1 and 2 Timothy and Titus on midweek Bible classes. Combined with sermons on Sundays (where we take turns with other brothers) I have quite a big number of Bible studies and sermons both personal and public which require many hours of preparation.



In October I had a great opportunity to bring some of our young people to the youth seminar in Dnipro. It's one of the best ways to encourage youth in their faith in God and to help them connect with a big number of young Christians.



Also our congregation had to move to a different place since we are growing slowly but steadily. It's been almost six years since it got started, and now we have no less than 15 people in attendance (sometimes even more). So our previous place got too small for us, and the owner made a decision to discontinue the lease. However, we thank God that we could find a new place (slightly bigger than the previous one) for the same amount of money. We are praying that in future our church could get a place of its own, so that the church wouldn't lose some part of its work during each move.



During the past 2 months there was a new wave of Covid raging in Ukraine just like in the rest of the world. Unfortunately, this time it touched God's church. About 10 members of the church of Christ passed away in different towns and cities. We are comforted to know that they are with the Lord now. However, it's a great loss for the church here on earth in Ukraine.

My family and I are grateful for your prayers and financial support that you provide to help God's work here in Ukraine.
