Dear brothers and sisters,

Greetings in the Lord! We are grateful to God for each new day of ministry, opportunities for spiritual growth, and shared work even in the challenging circumstances of war. With love, we share the summary of the summer ministry of the Lviv Church of Christ.

Bible Teaching

Throughout the summer, our congregation in Lviv gathered regularly for Sunday and midweek Bible classes for adults and youth. We devoted time to deeper study of the Scriptures, sharing experiences, and the practical application of faith in daily life. Children, teenagers, and adults are growing together in the knowledge of the Lord and learning to take responsibility in ministry.

Women's Ministry

Women's groups remained active in July and August. Sisters regularly met for Bible study, prayer, and spiritual support for one another. New participants joined the common study of the Bible, and the group continues to grow both in number and in harmony.

Children's Programs and Sunday School

In addition to the summer “Jesus Kids: Learning the Bible in English” program, every Sunday the main Sunday School for children was held, divided into two age groups. For the older group, once a month we teach the doctrine of the Church of Christ. This helps lay a deeper spiritual foundation and form a biblical worldview for our teenagers.

"Amerikraine" Camp

In August, the "Amerikraine" summer camp took place in Lviv. The Lviv Church of Christ actively participated in organizing, conducting lessons and spiritual. The greatest joy of this camp was the baptism of a woman who believed and joined the Kingdom of God and our church. This fruit of ministry is a powerful testimony to God's love and the power of the Gospel.

Evangelism in Drohobych

Since April, we have been regularly traveling every Sunday (after the service in Lviv, about an hour and a half by car) to the city of Drohobych for evangelistic work among displaced people and local residents. Along with Bogdana Chyhvinsev and youth from Lviv, we have also preached on the streets directly from the trunk of a car. We hold Bible meetings,

distribute humanitarian aid, and support people in their spiritual search. The active core of the Lviv community is continuously involved in this ministry.

Supporting Churches in Kyiv

In August, I was invited to the Church of Christ in the Vinogradar district of Kyiv to teach doctrine for two days. The brothers and sisters asked to continue such educational trips monthly until the end of the year — a great opportunity to strengthen and unite the churches around the truth of God's Word.

Church Life in Lviv

The church remains active, maintaining constant prayer, spiritual mentoring, and brotherly support. Gatherings, home prayers, welcoming new members, and developing mutual assistance are clear signs of unity in Christ even during this time of trial.

Special Circumstances and Gratitude

The war continues and has intensified in the Lviv region recently — we often have to spend time in shelters. We especially need your ongoing prayers for protection, strength, and peace for Ukraine. My heartfelt thanks to everyone for your prayerful and financial support — together with you, we can do much for God's glory!
