Hello to our friends and family. Here is our latest Ukraine newsletter. We are grateful to God for His constant guidance, protection, and the many opportunities for ministry, spiritual growth, and service even in these challenging times. With joy and thanksgiving, we share the summary of the ministry of the Lviv Church of Christ for the period January–April 2026.



Throughout this period, our congregation in Lviv continued to gather faithfully for Sunday worship services and midweek Bible studies for adults, youth, and children. These meetings remain a central part of our church life, where we study Scripture, pray together, and encourage one another in faith.

## Lviv Bible School

The **Lviv Bible School** continues its work, equipping believers with deeper biblical knowledge. Students are growing in understanding of Scripture, doctrine, and personal discipleship, preparing themselves for active service in the Church and evangelism.

## Youth Ministry

In **January**, we held a **Youth Seminar**, which gathered young people from our congregation and guests. It was a blessed time of teaching, fellowship, worship, and spiritual encouragement. The seminar helped strengthen faith among youth and motivated them toward active service in the church.

In **March**, we had a special opportunity to take a group of our youth to a **youth camp in Belgium**. This international experience was very impactful for the participants, broadening their vision of the global Church and strengthening their commitment to Christ and mission.



## Winter Retreat

In **February**, We organized **Ukrainian Winter Retreat**, which gathered believers from different regions of Ukraine. This was church retreat that brought together Christians of different ages. It was a powerful time of worship, teaching, prayer, and fellowship. The retreat provided spiritual renewal, encouragement, and unity among churches, strengthening faith and vision for ministry across Ukraine.

## Baptisms

We praise God for His work of salvation among people.

- In **January**, we had **one baptism** in Lviv, as a new soul responded to the Gospel and joined the Church of Christ.
- In **April**, we had **two baptisms in Lviv**, giving glory to God for the transformation and new life in Christ.

In addition, we are thankful for the fruit of ministry in Drohobych:

- In **April**, there were **three baptisms in Drohobych**, as people responded to the Gospel and became part of the Church.

**In total, from January to April, we had six baptisms**, and we give all glory to God for His saving work.

## Women's Ministry

The women's ministry remains active and spiritually fruitful. On **March 8th**, the sisters organized a special **Women's Event in the church**, dedicated to fellowship, encouragement, and outreach. This gathering also served as an evangelistic opportunity, where new guests were invited to the church and heard the message of the Gospel.

The women continue to meet regularly for Bible study and prayer.



### Evangelism and Humanitarian Ministry

The church continues its humanitarian aid program, through which we provide practical help to people in need. This ministry remains an important bridge for sharing the Gospel, as through acts of mercy we continue to proclaim Christ's love to those around us.

Alongside this, we maintain regular evangelistic outreach, Bible studies, and personal conversations with people seeking truth and hope. These efforts continue to bring spiritual fruit and open doors for further ministry.



### Ministry in Drohobych

In **April**, we were blessed to find and begin cooperation with a **new preacher for the city of Drohobych**. This is an important step for the further development of the church work in this city.

We continue supporting evangelistic efforts in Drohobych, including Bible studies, outreach activities, and humanitarian service, reaching both displaced people and local residents.

We are especially encouraged that in **April, three people were baptized in Drohobych**, which is a visible fruit of ongoing evangelism and faithful ministry in the city.

The church in Lviv remains active, united, and committed to prayer, fellowship, and mutual care. Despite the ongoing war and difficult circumstances, the body of Christ continues to grow in unity and service.
